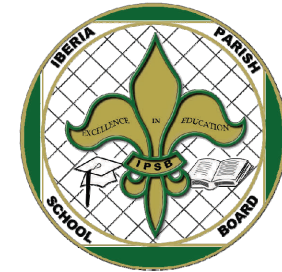
Parent Participation

Mission Statement

Iberia Virtual Program (IVP) aims to expand the educational choices for students in a quality virtual environment in order to enhance students' ability to be college and career ready.



Program Description

IVP is an option to traditional public school, where students access standards-based courses monitored by highly-qualified/certified instructors through an online format.

Ideal Online Student Characteristics

Students selected for the program will need to possess the following:

- ◆ A desire to learn independently
- ◆ Self-motivation
- ◆ Good time management skills
- ◆ A preference for anytime/anywhere learning versus the traditional classroom
- ◆ The ability to complete assignments on time
- ◆ Computer literate (able to perform basic tasks on a computer or mobile device)
- ◆ The ability to read and comprehend complex materials

Criteria for Enrollment

Students desiring to participate in IVP must complete the application process with the guidance counselor from the local middle or high school for which they are zoned to attend.

Enrollment Options

◆ Complete Virtual — Grades 7-8

Students can complete all middle school courses online through a virtual learning software platform that meets all required academics.

◆ Blended Model — Grades 9-12

Student will have the opportunity to complete Carnegie unit coursework through a combination of traditional and virtual curriculum. Some courses will still have to be taken by the traditional model in order to obtain a vocational *Area of Concentration (AOC)* required for graduation.



Student Grades

Progress reports will be available to parents using the parent portal. Students will receive a report through the online software that illustrates their progress towards course completion. Additional opportunities for success will be offered by the virtual facilitator and content specialists.
